

Billie's Daily Screening Guidance

Visual Screening (Observation Only)

- Unusual coloration (flushed or pale)
- Unusual behavior (behavior change, lethargy, unusual fatigue)
- New or significant coughing
- Respiratory symptoms not typical for student
- Shortness of breath
- Chills
- Appearing ill
- Vomiting

Student Complaint (Verbal Report)

- Nausea/Vomiting/ Diarrhea
- Headache
- Muscle pain
- Fever
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- General unwell feeling

If a student is positive of visual screening symptoms or complains of symptoms of illness, send them to the office for further screening.
